Celiac disease is an incurable, hereditary, auto-immune disease that recent studies show affect as many as 1 in 133 people in the United States. Is this a rare disease? Hardly...1 in 133 equates to approximately 1.5 million people. Frequently misdiagnosed, Celiac disease has a broad range of symptoms and no "typical" symptoms. The symptoms of Celiac disease are triggered by the ingestion of gluten, the protein found in wheat, rye, barley and perhaps oats.

If you or a family member suffer from anemia, weight loss or gain, diarrhea, osteoporosis, skin disorder, irritable bowel, mood swings or other unexplainable symptoms - **Maybe it's something you ate... Maybe it's Celiac Disease.**
